YOUTH TRACK PROGRAM

The MCS Youth Track Program is for students in grades 5-6. This program is designed to give students an introduction to Track and Field. The program consists of a minimum of 2 practices per week after school, usually 3:30-to 4:30. We will have approximately 4 regular meets and a Championship meet. These will be held after school at St Luke's High School on a weekday and the Championship meet is usually on Saturday. There will be relay teams, field events, and individual races.

The cost to participate is \$40.00. Each participant will be responsible for their own black running shorts and shoes. A good pair of comfortable running shoes will be fine for any of the events that are offered. If you do chose to purchase track shoes make sure you get rubber spikes rather than metal ones.

Anyone interested in participating should fill out the information on the attached form and return to school with payment on Wednesday Jan. 20. I will send a schedule for practice days for the rest of the season as soon as the meet schedule is set by the association.
