I am very excited to announce that we are gearing up for Mobile Christian's first (that I know of) Read-a-thon, which will run from February 3-February 17. Our Read-a-Thon website is:

What Will Happen During the Read-a-Thon? During this time, students will find donors that would like to help support MCS and our library program and set up a reader website where they will keep track of how much they read and the donations that they have collected. Information for setting up these pages will come home next Monday. Between the 3rd and the 17th, students will participate in reading sessions in class, in the library, as well as at home and those times will be logged thru the student sites.

What Happens With the Money Raised? 90% of what is raised comes back to MCS and its students. This is far more than any other fundraiser that I have found thus far. Please note that the money raised thru the Read-a-Thon and other library fundraisers not only purchases new books for the library, but also pays for such things as Accelerated Reader (and the accompanying parties) and Discovery Education, a video and extension website used in our classrooms to make learning more exciting for our students.

Will There Be Prizes? Yes! When they have raised their money, students will be able to log-in and "shop" for their prizes because not everyone wants the same prize. ⁽²⁾

What Do You Need To Do? Please encourage your child/children to ask grandparents, neighbors, and friends to support them in this endeavor. More importantly, please encourage your child to read EVERYDAY, not just during the Read-a-Thon. As a way of providing more books and more time for you and your child to read together, the MCS library will be open early (7 am) and later in the afternoons (until 4) February 6th-16th if you would like to come and borrow some of our books or use this time to read to/with your child. **Business Sponsorships**--Please note that the Read-a-Thon does offer business sponsorships so if you or your business would like to advertise and support the school simultaneously, please let me know. Business sponsors will have their business advertised on the group page, class pages, reader dashboards, and all donation pages. Business sponsors will also be listed in our school library as "Friends of Our Library" until next year's Read-a-Thon.
