#### IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

1. Tiger (Leopard) Walk begins @ 9:15 a.m.

- 2. Game begins @ 11:00 a.m.
- 3. No stadium seats with arms. No cameras with detachable lens. No artificial noise makers.
- Each ticket holder is allowed one large, clear bag such as a one-gallon Ziploc style bag or clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bag that does not exceed 12" X 6" X 12", plus a small clutch purse.
- For games with a start time before 5 p.m.: Parking will be directed to the Ag Heritage Lot located at Donahue Drive and Samford Avenue, and at the Hay Field Lot at Donahue Drive and Lem Morrison.
- 6. Free shuttles will be available on Thursday and Friday to and from the stadium. The shuttle will run from these lots from 8 a.m. until 90 minutes after the conclusion of the day's final game.
- Please make your plans to arrive in time to park, ride the shuttle and be in place for the Tiger (Leopard) Walk at 9:15 a.m.
- The school will not be organizing a fan bus. However if a parent group organizes a fan bus, we will pass that information along.
