The elementary years are important for your children to develop their beliefs about God and the world. Different from every other K-12 Christian school in Mobile, MCS provides your students with daily chapel and Bible classes. Helping your children grow in faith, service and gratitude is a priority.

Teachers focus on humility and service both in and out of the classroom, teaching lessons that will impact your children for eternity. This spirit of thankfulness, service and kindness grows from their teachers' reliance on the love of God. As their teachers focus on following Jesus, your children will learn from their examples of encouragement, forgiveness and trust in the Father.



BIBLE

Your children will study the Bible as a subject every year. Because MCS is a Christian school, we regard this class as the most important one for preparing them for LIFE, both on this earth and for eternity.

In Mobile Christian's elementary program, your children will study the Bible sequentially through Biblical Choices, a scripture-based curriculum. This curriculum will actively involve them in exciting and meaningful object lessons and illustrations geared toward a variety of learning styles. Through these studies, your children will be encouraged to make good choices and to use the Bible as their standard for living. Their first-semester lessons will be from the Old Testament, and their second-semester studies will focus on the New Testament.

The mission of the Bible Department coincides with the mission of MCS — to help students grow in the ways that Jesus grew (Luke 2:52): mentally, morally, physically and spiritually.

CHAPEL

Your children will benefit from daily chapel that will provide them with additional spiritual, academic, personal and leadership experiences outside the traditional classroom. They will worship through scripture reading, singing and prayer led by staff and/or students. Having this time as elementary students will reinforce your children's understanding of what it means to be lifelong followers of Christ and to love God and other people.

SPIRITUAL EMPHASIS WEEK

In November, your children and their teachers will focus on how to better serve God and others as individuals and as a school family. They will listen to guest speakers, participate in special chapel services and witness amazing things happening with their school and classmates, as they serve within and outside of Mobile Christian.

ENRICHMENT //

From the day your three-year-old students begin at Mobile Christian, they will have enrichment classes outside of the regular classroom. From K3 through fifth grade, your children will grow from classes in Spanish, library, computer, music and art at least once a week with teachers who are specialized in these fields. You will quickly see why parents and students find enrichment classes to be such a special part of their family's experience at Mobile Christian.



FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Through singing, conversation, coloring and writing, your children will learn Spanish words and phrases and gain an appreciation for Hispanic people and cultures. Their elementary Spanish classes will lay a foundation for learning more difficult aspects of the language. One of their favorite parts about learning Spanish may be speaking to others about God and Jesus in another language.

MUSIC/BEGINNING BAND

Your children's elementary music education will utilize National Music Education Standards for activity-based learning. They will experience music through singing, playing, listening, moving and analyzing. Additionally, they will develop musical skills at age appropriate levels, while gaining an understanding of music in relationship to other arts, history and culture. From preschool through fifth grade, your children will participate in the music program at least once a month.

Fourth graders will play the recorder, which will help them learn to focus on more than one thing at a time, follow music, play an instrument with a group, and hold an instrument. In beginning band, your fifth grade students will choose an instrument to determine if it is the best fit for them to grow and be successful. Being a band member can increase their comprehension and math skills, coordination and capacity for memory.

ART

Your children will grow by participating in art classes at least once a week from kindergarten through fifth grade. They will connect to their life and culture and express their life experiences through visual arts. They also will be challenged to think creatively, communicate thoughts and ideas, understand the opinions of others and expand technical skills.

LIBRARY

Complementing their kindergarten and pre-K curriculums, time in the library will allow your students to explore literature and God's world with books from A to Z. Older students will be encouraged to read books that they love, which not only will make them better readers and students but also better friends and people. Your children will be read to when they come to the library, enhancing their appreciation for stories and making the MCS Library a place where their love for books, one another and, most importantly, God is fostered through the use of fun, quality literature.

COMPUTER

Your students will visit the elementary computer lab weekly. Their technology skills will grow through their work with: Accelerated Reader, Edmodo, STAR, MobyMax, touch typing for speed and accuracy using Keyboarding Without Tears, understanding of Microsoft Office Suite (specifically Word, PowerPoint, Picture Manager and Excel), fundamental computing skills, fundamental Windows navigation, digital citizenship and internet safety.

ENHANCEMENTS



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Mobile Christian School enhancements play an important role in your elementary students' learning experience, from areas of technology to diverse clubs and organizations. Focused on providing the best opportunities for students, MCS was the first school in Mobile to include an elementary National Honor Society. The MCS administration and board value your input in creating memorable experiences for your children and family.



INTERACTIVE TELEVISIONS

Your children will have a state-of-the-art viewing experience through Clear Touch Interactive Panels. They provide 20 simultaneous points of touch, immediate access to mobile apps and software, device mirroring and wireless connectivity, so your children and their teachers can collaborate in real time.

COMPUTER AND CHROMEBOOK LABS

Two MCS computer labs will provide your students with support for their classroom subjects and opportunities to understand computer use, applications and research. Several portable Chromebook labs will enhance their learning in the classroom.

iPADS

As fourth and fifth graders, your students will access digital textbooks through iPads. They also will utilize iPad apps that will aid in their learning, including Google Classroom, Edmodo, Kahoot and more. This will allow them to have access to their textbooks on their iPads at school and at home.
