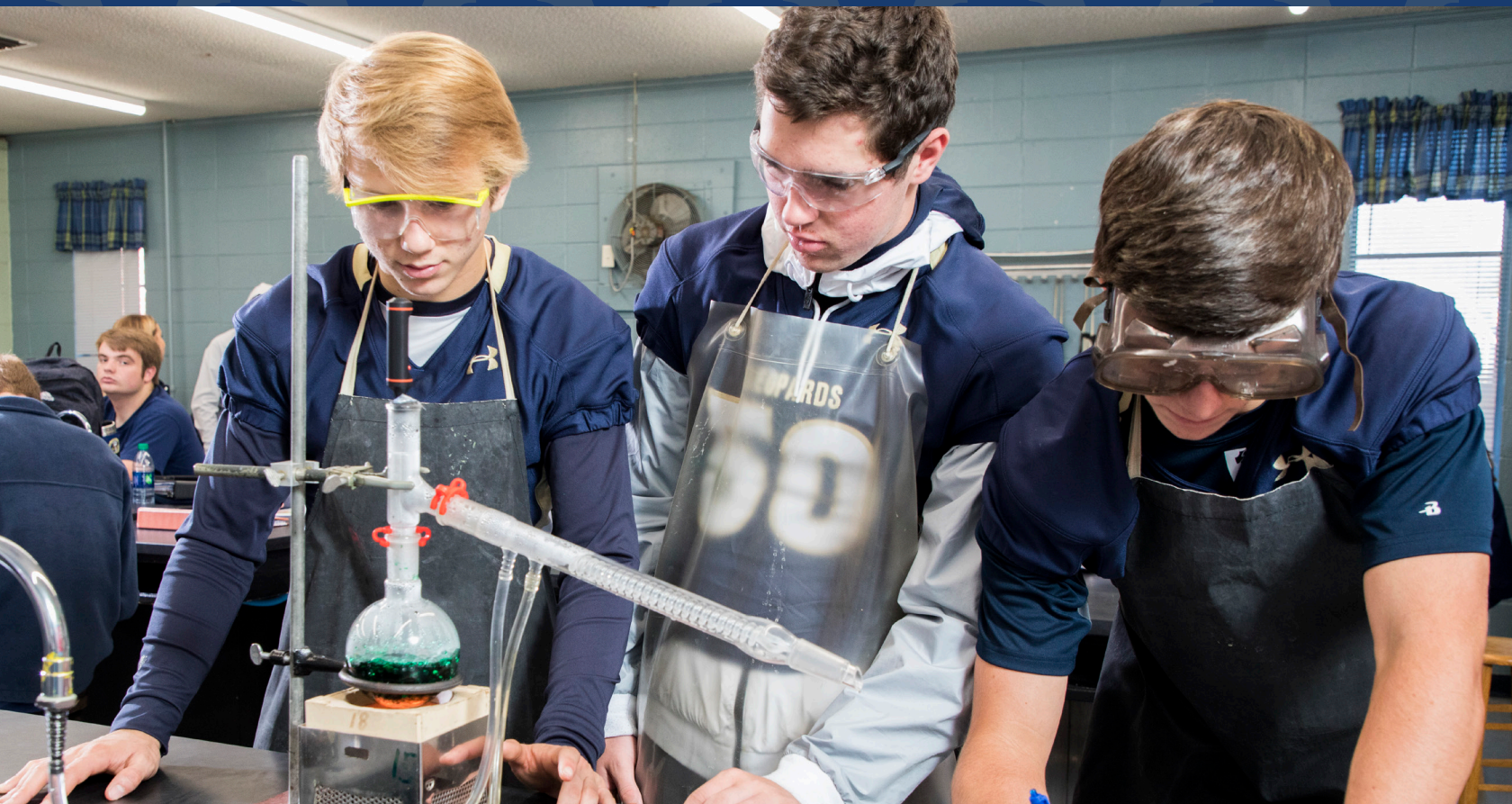


# MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL

## ACCREDITATION

Mobile Christian School is accredited by both Cognia and the National Christian School Association. Formerly known as AdvancED and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, Cognia is the largest accrediting organization in the world; it accredits more than 36,000 schools and universities in 83 countries and serves 25 million students. The National Christian School Association has accredited MCS based on the school's spiritual and academic aspects.

## TECHNOLOGY

Your MCS students will utilize the latest technology — including interactive touchscreen televisions, interactive white boards, LCD projectors, public address systems, computers, Chromebooks and fiber optic lines. Two MCS computer labs will provide them with opportunities to understand computer use, applications and research, and several portable Chromebook labs will enhance their learning in the classroom.

## iPADS

From fourth grade through senior year, your students will use iPads. They also will utilize iPad apps that will aid in their learning, including Google Classroom, Edmodo, Kahoot and more. This will allow them to have access to their textbooks on their iPads at school and at home.
