#### SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

\*Alabama Association of School Office Personnel will award up to \$1,000 scholarship to students pursuing a degree from a college of business or K-12 education. Please download and complete the AASOP Scholarship and submit by **February 1**, **2018**.

\*Smith Scholarship Foundation: Accountability Scholarship Program providing assistance to High School Seniors who have "given back" to their community through volunteer activities or by caring for family while overcoming financial and personal challenges. Up to \$15,000 a year in financial assistance. Applications with letters of recommendation must be submitted by **January 7, 2019**.

\*New Scholarship at UA: UA Recognition - A student with a 21-24 ACT or 1060-1190 SAT score and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 will be selected as a UA Recognition Scholar and will receive \$8,000 over 4 years (\$2,000 per year)
