## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

\***New Scholarship at UA:** UA Recognition - A student with a 21-24 ACT or 1060-1190 SAT score and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 will be selected as a UA Recognition Scholar and will receive \$8,000 over 4 years (\$2,000 per year)

\***FINANCE:** [BadCredit.org](http://BadCredit.org) – just launched a scholarship offer that's available to students who are seeking a career in finance or a related industry.

\***Prudential Spirit of Community Awards** – access the application at <https://spirit.prudential.com/awards/how-to-apply> could win \$1,000 and a trip to Washington, D.C. in May.

\***Alabama State Grant Program** is available only to students attending an eligible independent Alabama college or university. This is not a need based program. Grant amounts vary from year-to-year based on the availability of funds, but cannot exceed \$1,200 per academic year. Applications are available from the financial aid office at the institution you plan to attend. Application deadline dates are printed on the application form. The following institutions are the only participants of the Alabama State Grant Program: Amridge University, Birmingham Southern College, Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Judson College, Miles College, Oakwood University, Samford University, South University – Montgomery, Springhill College, Stillman College, U.S. Sports Academy, University of Mobile. Please DO NOT submit this application to an institution not listed.
