The Linly Heflin scholarship awards Alabama women seeking help with their undergraduate degree at four-year accredited Alabama colleges and universities. Scholarships are awarded annually for four years or until graduation, whichever comes first. Applicants must be female, from Alabama, a U.S. citizen and must attend a four-year accredited Alabama college/university and full-time.

\*Alabama State Grant Program is available only to students attending an eligible independent Alabama college or university. This is not a need based program. Grant amounts vary from year-to-year based on the availability of funds, but cannot exceed \$1,200 per academic year. Applications are available from the financial aid office at the institution you plan to attend. Application deadline dates are printed on the application form. The following institutions are the only participants of the Alabama State Grant Program: Amridge University, Birmingham Southern College, Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Judson College, Miles College, Oakwood University, Samford University, South University – Montgomery, Springhill College, Stillman College, U.S. Sports Academy, University of Mobile. Please DO NOT submit this application to an institution not listed.
