# Counselor's Corner

## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**\*J.L. Bedsole Foundation Scholarship – DEADLINE is November 30<sup>th</sup>.**

Criteria: demonstrated leadership capacity, demonstrated community service capacity, academic standards and financial need. Must express a desire to use their abilities to further the civic, cultural and economic development of southwest Alabama. Leadership is the most important criteria. Furthermore, candidates must be planning to pursue a Baccalaureate degree at a qualifying 4-year institution within Alabama.

**\*Alabama Association of School Office Personnel** will award up to \$1,000 scholarship to students pursuing a degree from a college of business or K-12 education. Please download and complete the AASOP Scholarship and submit by **February 1, 2018**.

**\*Smith Scholarship Foundation:** Accountability Scholarship Program providing assistance to High School Seniors who have “given back” to their community through volunteer activities or by caring for family while overcoming financial and personal challenges. Up to \$15,000 a year in financial assistance. Applications with letters of recommendation must be submitted by **January 7, 2019**.

**\*New Scholarship at UA:** UA Recognition - A student with a 21-24 ACT or 1060-1190 SAT score and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 will be selected as a UA Recognition Scholar and will receive \$8,000 over 4 years (\$2,000 per year)

**\*FINANCE: BadCredit.org** – just launched a scholarship offer that’s available to students who are seeking a career in finance or a related industry.

**\*Alabama Home Builders Scholarship** for more information go to <https://ahbfoundation.org/index.php/scholarships> **(Due March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019)** Must be interested in pursuing one of these majors or something that will lead to residential building: Note: This list is not exclusive to other trades. Should an applicant demonstrate that their education will lead to a career in residential building, the AHB Foundation Scholarship Committee will consider the application for possible funding.

**\*Linly Heflin Scholarship** - \$20,000 **(Deadline Dec. 31, 2018)** For more information or to apply go to <http://www.linlyheflin.org/scholarship-information/>. The Linly Heflin scholarship awards Alabama women seeking help with their undergraduate degree at four-year accredited Alabama colleges and universities. Scholarships are awarded annually for four years or until graduation, whichever comes first. Applicants must be female, from Alabama, a U.S. citizen and must attend a four-year accredited Alabama college/university and full-time.

**\*Alabama State Grant Program** is available only to students attending an eligible independent Alabama college or university. This is not a need based program. Grant amounts vary from year-to-year based on the availability of funds, but cannot exceed \$1,200 per academic year. Applications are available from the financial aid office at the institution you plan to attend. Application deadline dates are printed on the application form. The following institutions are the only participants of the Alabama State Grant Program: Amridge University, Birmingham Southern College, Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Judson College, Miles College, Oakwood University, Samford University, South University – Montgomery, Springhill College, Stillman College, U.S. Sports Academy, University of Mobile. Please DO NOT submit this application to an institution not listed. Alabama Student Grant Program Application 2018-2019 (Please return completed application to the Financial Aid Office of the participating institution.)
